“THE PROBLEMS OF BALKAN MORPHOSYNTAX”

The 18th volume of “Slavia Meridionalis” will be devoted to the problems of Balkan morphosyntax in synchronic perspective.

The focus will be on the Balkan languages area with particular emphasis on South Slavic languages in the context of both the single-language and comparative studies. We are interested in processes taking place within the Balkan sprachbund as well as in the influence of other languages on the area. Therefore, we encourage submission of papers representative of various disciplines and specializations.

The following topics will be covered in this volume:

- Formal and semantic properties and the rules of combinatorics and significant units of the language system: morphology, morphophonology, syntax, word formation, lexicology, phraseology.
- Function of the language units in the text.
- Mechanisms, tendencies, innovations in language system and in the text.
- Language corpora and text databases as sources of research material in terms of single-language and comparative studies.
- The problems of Balkan morphosyntax in the areal perspective.

“Slavia Meridionalis” is a multidisciplinary journal, publishing papers on Southern Slavs, as well as their interactions with other regions. The journal is included in the European Reference Index for the Humanities and the Social Sciences (ERIH Plus).

Authors are invited to submit papers of up to 40,000 characters with spaces (including graphs, tables, bibliography and abstract in English) in English, German, French, Spanish, and all Slavic languages.
